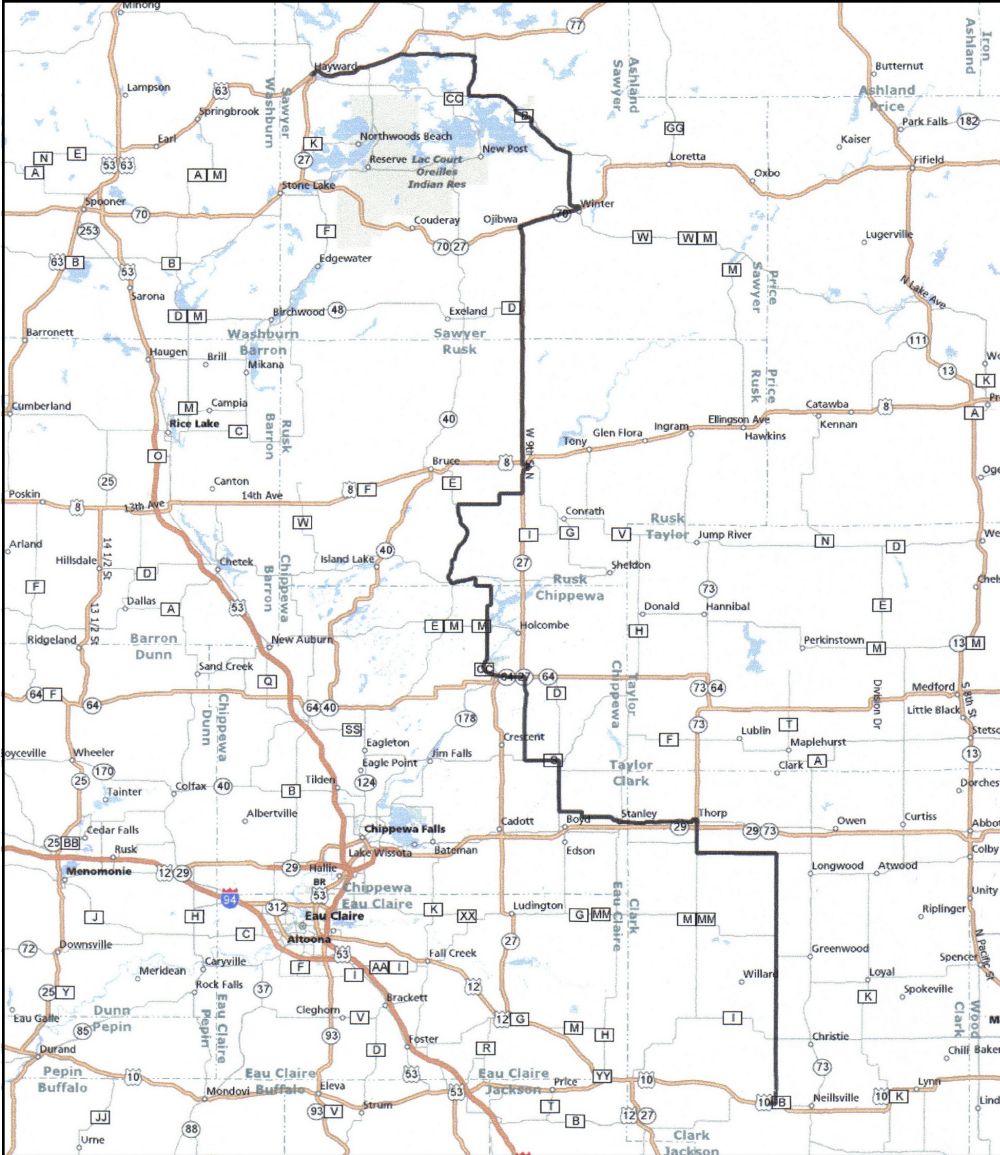


Northern Route Highground Bicycle Tour



The Highground is a 146-acre manned veterans memorial park that pays tribute to the dead, and honors the survivors, their service, and their sacrifices. Our mission of healing and education is fulfilled with the generous efforts of volunteers and contributors. Each year six fundraising bicycle routes converge on The Highground in August in support of our mission.

On the Northern Route, one will enjoy a 170 mile family friendly ride. The route mostly follows lightly traveled county roads. When on state roads, a large shoulder is available for safe riding. One of the many highlights of the ride is on the second day when the route parallels the Flambeau River. Riders enjoy plenty of rest stops as well as large evening and breakfast meals at over night locations. Showers are available and riders can set up a tent if they prefer. Support staff is available to ensure the rider are having a safe and enjoyable ride.
